It will be necessary to remove and replace an undersized drainage culvert located at 6778 Trussville Clay Road between Old Springville Road and McFrancis Road. Trussville Clay Road must be temporarily closed to complete the work.

The construction is scheduled on Friday, February 8, 2019 through Saturday, February 9, 2019. The road will be re-opened and normal traffic operations will be restored as soon as practical.

Signs notifying the public of the temporary road closure will be posted on Trussville Clay Road for a period of one week prior to construction. The City of Clay and the 911 Center will be notified in advance of the road work and temporary closure.

A detour route will be established and traffic control signs and barricades will be installed and maintained in accordance with the Federal Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
