A RESOLUTION RELEASING THE LIEN FOR ABATEMENT OF WEEDS ON THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 5749 DESOTO DRIVE, PINSON, ALABAMA 35126

WHEREAS, 5749 Desoto Drive was found to be in violation of Ordinance 2010-03; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution 2012-32 authorizing the abatement of weeds on the property located at 5749 Desoto Drive, Pinson, Alabama 35126, and abatement took place in October 2012; and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution 2012-32 on November 19, 2012, allowing the City Clerk to file a lien of \$260.00 with the Jefferson County Probate Court; and,

WHEREAS, payment of \$260.00 was received by the City of Clay for the abatement lien.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council declares this lien to be satisfied and authorizes the City Manager to file this Resolution to release a lien for abatement of weeds at 5749 Desoto Drive with the Jefferson County Probate Court.
