A Resolution to Award a Bid for Directional Signs

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama has solicited competitive bids pursuant to the Public Works Bid Law, Act 97-225 of the Alabama Legislature, for directional signs; and,

WHEREAS, The City Council resolves to let the bid to the lowest responsible bidder, according to the special specifications determined and placed on file with the City Clerk; and,

WHEREAS, the invitation for bids was advertised with the opening date set forth in the bids and the City Council opened said bids in its regular City Council meeting of November 1, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, the invitation for bids was sent out to four companies and only one response was received with the total bid being as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Clay that the Sign Shop is determined to be a responsible bidder, the bid amount being \$10,788.68 and that a contract will be awarded to such bidder.
