A Proclamation to Honor SSG Michael Wesley Hosey

Whereas, on Saturday, September 17, 2011, SSG Michael Wesley Hosey of Clay, Alabama, was killed from wounds sustained while serving his country in Uruzgan Province, Afghanistan; and

Whereas, SSG Michael Wesley Hosey was a member of the United States Army - 3rd Battalion, 1st Special Forces Group (Airborne), Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington on his fourth overseas deployment having previously served two tours of duty in Iraq and one tour of duty in Afghanistan; and

Whereas, SSG Michael Wesley Hosey provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the City of Clay, County of Jefferson, State of Alabama, and the United States of America, serving dutifully and making the ultimate sacrifice on our behalf; and

Whereas, the people of Clay, Alabama knew SSG Michael Wesley Hosey as a graduate of Clay Chalkville High School who loved his family, was a man of faith and a man with a sense of humor who always wanted to serve his country; and

Whereas, all of the citizens of Clay, Alabama, mourn the death of SSG Michael Wesley Hosey and the loss to his family, friends, and community.
