**WHEREAS**, Nimrod Long and Associates has submitted a contract proposal of a lump sum fee of \$19,500.00 for design services for Phase II of the Cosby Lake Park Master Plan.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Clay that the Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Nimrod Long and Associates for \$19,500.00 for design services for Phase II of the Cosby Lake Park Master Plan; and,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Mayor is authorized to sign the contract in the name of the municipality, with the City Manager's attestation to the Mayor's signature.
