## A RESOLUTION ABATING THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 7535 OLD SPRINGVILLE ROAD, TRUSSVILLE, ALABAMA, 351736

**Whereas**, THE City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama adopted Ordinance 2005-57 on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2005; and

**Whereas**, said Ordinance was adopted to provide for the condemnation, demolition and abatement of dangerous buildings and structures within the City Limits of Clay, Alabama; and

**Whereas**, the City Council adopted Resolution 2016-19 authorizing the demolition of the property located at 7535 Old Springville Road, Trussville, AL, 35173, and said demolition took place in September, 2016; and

**Whereas**, Resolution 2016-42 awards the bid for demolition of the property located at 7535 Old Springville Road, Trussville, AL 35173, for the amount of \$12,700.00

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama declares the property at 7535 Old Springville Road, Trussville, AL 35173 to be demolished and abated. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to file with the Probate Court of Jefferson County a lien for said abatement in the amount of \$12,700.00
