## STATE OF ALABAMA JEFFERSON COUNTY CITY OF CLAY

### A PROCLAMATION DESIGNATING THE CITY OF CLAY, AS A “LET’S MOVE CITY”

**WHEREAS**, the Clay City Council supports efforts to (1) help parents make healthy family choices; (2) create healthy schools; (3) provide access to healthy and affordable foods; and (4) promote physical activity; and

**WHEREAS**, it is with great enthusiasm that the City of Clay joins the First Lady and the “*Let’s Move!*” campaign to make a difference in the lives of our families and most especially of our children, and in keeping with goals of the City of Clay, we pledge to fight for our children.
