A RESOLUTION ABATING THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 5530 SAN MARCOS DRIVE, PINSON, ALABAMA, 35126

Whereas, THE City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama adopted Ordinance 2010-03 on the 15th day of February 15, 2010; and

Whereas, said Ordinance was adopted to provide for the condemnation, demolition and abatement of dangerous buildings and structures within the City Limits of Clay, Alabama; and

Whereas, the City Council adopted Resolution 2012-17 authorizing the demolition of the property located at 5530 San Marcos Drive, Pinson, Alabama, 35126, and said demolition took place in October 2012; and

Whereas, the Resolution 2012-24 awards the bid for demolition of the property located at 5530 San Marcos Drive, Pinson, Alabama, 35126, for the amount of \$4,698.00

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama declares that the property demolished at 5530 San Marcos Drive, Pinson, Alabama, 35126. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to file an assessment at Clay City Hall for said abatement in the amount of \$4,698.00
