PRE-COUNCIL MINUTES April 23rd, 2019

The City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama held a Pre-Council meeting on Tuesday, April 23rd, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall with Mayor Webster presiding and City Manager, Ronnie Dixon, serving as recorder.

Mayor Webster called the meeting to order.

The council and Mayor discussed the agenda. Council will present a Proclamation to recognize Khalil bell. Public hearings include abatement on 5530 San Marcos and 7501 Stoney Creek. Zoning hearing from Planning and zoning for Highland Green. Mayor's Prayer breakfast scheduled for May $3^{\rm rd}$.

Lawyer Summers updated Council on 7153 Cabin Lane. Chase Bank will send monies for the demolition of the property and the City will award bid to demolish.

Mayor Webster explained the Freedom from Addiction Coalition meeting he attended on Friday 4/20/19. Dr. Tom Dooley will be present at Council meeting to speak on this subject. June 4th will be a kick off meeting for our local Coalition to be held at the Trussville Civic Center at 7am.

Mayor Webster spoke about the Academy of Craft Training school downtown where he teaches. School teaches 5 trades for 22 schools; 250 kids will be guaranteed a job when they graduate. Signing day on April 24, contractors on hand to offer jobs. Over 100 kids already committed to contractors.
