



ORDINANCE NO. 2013-16

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2003-103, AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama adopted Ordinance 2003 – 103 on January 5, 2004; and,

WHEREAS, the provisions of this Ordinance, including the fee schedule, may from time to time be amended, supplemented, changed, modified or repealed by the City Council; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama that Section III, Subsection C shall be amended as follows:

C. Retail Store. A retail establishment whose primary function is the sale of packaged or unprepared food and grocery items for consumption off the premises and/or the sale of household items and whose annual gross sales of alcoholic beverages do not exceed five (5) percent of its total gross sales from all sources as evidenced by a certified audit showing the sales for a calendar year most recently ending at the proposed location for a similar store at a similar location. For the purposes of this ordinance, retail establishments selling gasoline shall not be considered retail stores.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama that all references to “Grocery Store” as defined by Section III, Subsection C of the original ordinance shall now read “Retail Store” as defined by this ordinance (City of Clay Ordinance 2013-16).
