



# CITY OF CLAY, ALABAMA ORDINANCE 2011 – 03

## An Ordinance Amending Ordinance 2010-01 An Ordinance To Adopt Various Standardized Building Codes

---

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama, on January 19, 2010, adopted Ordinance 2010-01 which established various standardized codes relating to inspection activities and enforcement of building standards as provided in said codes for the City of Clay, Jefferson County, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council of Clay, Alabama, that certain fees should be modified; and

WHEREAS, this amendment shall apply to the permit issuance fees adopted by the City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clay, that Ordinance 2010-01 is hereby amended as follows by modifying Section XI to change the permit issuance fees:

### Section XI Issuance Fee

All residential, apartment, commercial, industrial and institutional construction permits will be assessed an issuance fee of \$10 plus permit fees with the exception of Building Permits – New Construction – which will be assessed an issuance fee of \$25 plus permit fees. This applies to all permits in this Ordinance described in Section XII.A; Section XII.B; Section XII.C; and Section XII.D.

All provisions of Ordinance 2010-01 not modified hereby shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after adoption and publication as required by law.
