A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLAY, ALABAMA, APPROVING THE MAYOR TO PURSUE A FEMA HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT FOR A FIRST RESPONDER SAFEROOM WHICH COULD RESULT IN THE PROJECT APPROVAL, AND THE COMMITTEMENT OF CITY FUNDS, OR CONTRIBUTIONS TO MAKE UP THE CITY OF CLAY, ALABAMA'S, GRANT MATCH.

BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council of Clay, Alabama, provides approval to allow the mayor to pursue a FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant for a first responder safe room which could result in the project approval, and the commitment of city funds, or contributions to make up the City of Clay, Alabama's grant match.

At the completion of the grant application process in January 2015, Mayor Webster will sign and execute the AEMA/FEMA HMGP Grant application which is a legal document between AEMA/FEMA and the City of Clay.
