## A Resolution Authorizing the Mayor to Execute a Contract for Traffic Photo Enforcement

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama hereby finds and declares that there is a significant risk to the health and safety of the community from vehicles driven in violation of certain traffic regulations, namely running red lights, speeding, failing to come to a complete stop before turning right on red, and failing to come to a complete stop at stop signs and that these actions create at minimum a public nuisance and often a public hazard; and

**WHEREAS**, more than 400 communities in the United States, including Montgomery, Alabama, have employed Photo Enforcement programs that have successfully improved driver behavior; and

**WHEREAS**, those communities utilizing Photo Enforcement are experiencing a reduction in certain traffic violations, crashes, injury, fatalities and property damage.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama request of the Alabama Legislative Delegation that represents the citizens of Clay offer and support Legislation authorizing the City of Clay to enact a Civil Ordinance providing for Photo Enforcement of red light and stop sign running and speeding; and

**NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract for Photo Enforcement with Redflex Traffic Systems subject to Legislative Photo Enforcement Authorization and that provides no out of pocket cost to the City of Clay.
