CITY COUNCIL MINUTES February 25th, 2025

The City Council of the City of Clay met in regular session on Tuesday, February 25th, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. at Clay City Hall. Mayor Charles Webster presided over the meeting and Ronnie Dixon served as recorder.

Councilor Dean Kirkner led in prayer. Mayor Webster led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Webster called the meeting to order and roll call was conducted as follows: Councilors Becky Johnson, Bo Johnson, Dean Kirkner, Chris Nail, Orletta Rush and Mayor Webster.

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of February 11th, 2025. Councilor Dean Kirkner made a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of February 11th, 2025, which was seconded by Councilor Bo Johnson and approved by a unanimous voice vote.
