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## CITY COUNCIL MINUTES July 11th, 2023

The City Council of the City of Clay met in regular session on Tuesday, July 11th, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. at Clay City Hall. Mayor Webster presided over the meeting and Ronnie Dixon served as recorder.

Councilor Bo Johnson led in prayer. Mayor Webster led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Webster called the meeting to order and roll call was conducted as follows: Councilors Becky Johnson, Bo Johnson, Dean Kirkner, Chris Nail, Orletta Rush and Mayor Webster.

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of June 27th, 2023. *Councilor Dean Kirkner made a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of June 27th, 2023, which was seconded by Councilor Orletta Rush and approved by a unanimous voice vote.*

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve tonight's Meeting Agenda. *Councilor Orletta Rush made a motion to approve the Meeting Agenda, which was seconded by Councilor Dan Kirkner and approved by a unanimous voice vote.*

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve tonight's Consent Agenda. *Councilor Bo Johnson made a motion to approve tonight's Consent Agenda, which was seconded by Councilor Chris Nail.* The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the following result: *Yeas: Johnson, Johnson, Kirkner, Nail, Rush and Mayor Webster.*

### **Under Reading of Petitions, Applications, Complaints, Appeals, Communications, etc.**

Under the **City Manager's report**, Ronnie reported the following: Saturday July 15<sup>th</sup>, The Church of the Highlands will be having a food distribution at the Love Lady Center as well as Faith United doing a Drug Awareness Program. Ronnie requested recommendations for two properties regarding safety issues: 5240 Baggett Drive and the property of the Old Small Engine Repair. Council recommends starting the demolition procedures.

**Public Hearings**, there was only one person present to speak for weed abatement; Ms. Chrislyn Pepper of 5239 Baggett Drive, however her case had already been closed.

**Ronnie Dixon introduced Resolution 2023-15** A Resolution Authorizing the Mayor to Sign an Agreement between the Athletic Shop and the City of Clay. *Councilor Bo Johnson made a motion to approve Resolution 2023-15 which was seconded by Councilor Chris Nail.* The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the results as follows: *Yeas: Councilors Johnson, Johnson, Kirkner, Nail, Rush and Mayor Webster.*

Under **Mayor and Council Comments**, The Mayor reminded everyone to be weather/temperature aware.



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**Councilor Becky Johnson** reported two new members for the Senior Center and updated Council on the roof repair.

**Councilor Bo Johnson** had no report

**Councilor Dean Kirkner** introduced Chris Horn to address the Council for Center Point Fire.

**Councilor Chris Nail** had no report.

**Councilor Orletta Rush** reminded everyone School starts back in three weeks with Kids On August 8<sup>th</sup>.

**Under Public comments**, Ms. Tamika Pope of 4429 Winchester Hills Way was present to address Council regarding speed bumps for the neighborhood.
