## STATE OF ALABAMA JEFFERSON COUNTY CITY OF CLAY

## A RESOLUTION RELEASING THE LIEN FOR ABATEMENT OF WEEDS ON THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 5209 BAGGETT DRIVE, PINSON, ALABAMA 35126

WHEREAS, 5209 Baggett Drive, Pinson, Alabama 35126 was found to be in violation of Ordinance 2010-03; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted Resolution 2019-14 authorizing the abatement of weeds on the property located at 5209 Baggett Drive, Pinson, Alabama 35126, and abatement took place in September 2019; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution 2019-23 on November 12, 2019, allowing the City Manager to file a lien of \$120.00 with the Jefferson County Probate Court; and,

WHEREAS, the City Manager recorded said lien as instrument number 2020009662; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution 2020-09 authorizing the abatement of weeds on the property located at 5209 Baggett Drive, Pinson, Alabama 35126, and abatement took place in August 2020; and,

**WHEREAS,** the City Council passed Resolution 2020-27 on October 13, 2020, allowing the City Manager to file a lien of \$215.00 with the Jefferson County Probate Court; and,

WHEREAS, the City Manager recorded said lien as instrument number 2021018690; and

WHEREAS, payment of \$335.00 was received by the City of Clay for the abatement lien.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council declares this lien to be satisfied and authorizes the City Manager to file this Resolution to release the liens for abatement of weeds at 5209 Baggett Drive, Pinson, Alabama 35126 with the Jefferson County Probate Court.
