The City Council of the City of Clay met in regular session on Tuesday, January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. at Clay City Hall. Mayor Webster presided over the meeting and Ronnie Dixon served as recorder.

Councilor Bo Johnson led in prayer. Mayor Webster led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Webster called the meeting to order and roll call was conducted as follows: Councilors Becky Johnson, Bo Johnson, Chris Nail, Orletta Rush and Mayor Webster
