**A RESOLUTION ABATING THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT

**Whereas**, THE City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama adopted Ordinance 2010-03 on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February 15, 2010; and

**Whereas**, said Ordinance was adopted to provide for the condemnation, demolition and abatement of dangerous buildings and structures within the City Limits of Clay, Alabama; and

**Whereas**, the City Council adopted Resolution 2014-50 authorizing the demolition of the property located at 5909 Elizabeth Drive, Trussville, AL, 35173, and said demolition took place in December 2014; and

**Whereas**, the Resolution 2014-50 awards the bid for demolition of the property located at 5909 Elizabeth Drive, Trussville, AL 35173, for the amount of \$13,500.00

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama declares the property at 5909 Elizabeth Drive, Trussville, AL 35173 to be demolished and abated. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to file with the Probate Court of Jefferson County a lien for said abatement in the amount of \$13,500.00
