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**A RESOLUTION RELEASING THE LIEN FOR ABATEMENT OF WEEDS ON THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 5749 DESOTO DRIVE, PINSON, ALABAMA 35126**

**WHEREAS**, 5749 Desoto Drive was found to be in violation of Ordinance 2010-03; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted Resolution 2012-32 authorizing the abatement of weeds on the property located at 5749 Desoto Drive, Pinson, Alabama 35126, and abatement took place in October 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council passed Resolution 2012-32 on November 19, 2012, allowing the City Clerk to file a lien of \$260.00 with the Jefferson County Probate Court; and,

**WHEREAS**, payment of \$260.00 was received by the City of Clay for the abatement lien.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council declares this lien to be satisfied and authorizes the City Manager to file this Resolution to release a lien for abatement of weeds at 5749 Desoto Drive with the Jefferson County Probate Court.
