

ORDINANCE 2020-02

An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance 2008-08

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAY, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** That the salary of the mayor of the City of Clay, Alabama shall be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of \$2,000.00 per month.
- **Section 2**. In addition to the salary provided for herein, the Mayor shall be entitled to additional compensation as provided below for the attendance and completion of Certified Municipal Official training established by the Alabama League of Municipalities:
- A. Upon completion of the prescribed courses by the Alabama League of Municipalities resulting in the awarding of the designation of "Certified Municipal Official", the mayor shall receive an additional \$1,000.00 per month for each certification level.
- B. Upon presentation of proof of the awarding of the designation of "Certified Municipal Official", either *basic*, *advanced*, *or emeritus* the Mayor shall be increased as provided herein beginning the next pay period after being awarded the designation.
- **Section 3.** That each councilmember shall be compensated at the sum of \$150.00 per meeting attended. Compensation not to exceed two meetings per month.
- **Section 4**. In addition to the salary provided for herein, the Councilmember shall be entitled to additional compensation as provided below for the attendance and completion of Certified Municipal Official training established by the Alabama League of Municipalities:
- A. Upon completion of the prescribed courses by the Alabama League of Municipalities resulting in the awarding of the designation of "Certified Municipal Official", the Councilmember shall receive an additional \$100.00 per month for each certification level.
- B. Upon presentation of proof of the awarding of the designation of "Certified Municipal Official", *basic*, *advanced*, *or emeritus*, the Councilmember shall be increased as provided herein beginning the next pay period after being awarded the designation.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective on the first Monday in November 2020 and shall continue in force and effect until repealed by action of the council.

Section 6. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable; if any portion of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such ruling shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.
