CITY COUNCIL MINUTES June 11th, 2024

The City Council of the City of Clay met in regular session on Tuesday, June 11th, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. at Clay City Hall. Mayor Webster presided over the meeting and Ronnie Dixon served as recorder.

Councilor Bo Johnson led in prayer. Mayor Webster led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Webster called the meeting to order and roll call was conducted as follows: Councilors Becky Johnson, Bo Johnson, Chris Nail and Mayor Webster

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of May 28th, 2024. *Councilor Bo Johnson made a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of May 28th, 2024, which was seconded by Councilor Chris Nail and approved by a unanimous voice vote.*
