



# CITY OF CLAY, ALABAMA ORDINANCE 2021-05

## AN AMENDING ORDINANCE 2015-17

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clay, adopted Ordinance 2015-17 on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2015; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2015-17 addresses on street parking; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama believes it to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Clay to address off-the-road vehicle operation on public streets; and,

WHEREAS, based on attorney general opinion 8600033, vehicles specifically designated by their manufacturers as off the road vehicles should not to be used on the streets and highways of this state.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama that Ordinance 2015-17 shall be amended to include the following:

“Any person operating an unlawful motorized vehicle upon public streets, shall upon conviction, be subject to a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or a jail sentence not to exceed 180 days, or both.”
