CITY COUNCIL MINUTES September 28th, 2021

The City Council of the City of Clay met in regular session on Tuesday, September 28, 2021, at 6:00 p.m. at Clay City Hall. Mayor Webster presided over the meeting and Ronnie Dixon, served as recorder.

Mayor Webster called the meeting to order and roll call was conducted as follows:

Councilor Bo Johnson led in prayer. Mayor Webster led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of September 14th, 2021. *Councilor Dean Kirkner made a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of September 14th, 2021, which was seconded by Councilor Bo Johnson and approved by a unanimous voice vote.*

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve tonight's Meeting Agenda. *Councilor Bo Johnson made a motion to approve tonight's Meeting Agenda, which was seconded by Councilor LeWayne Allen and approved by a unanimous voice vote.*

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve tonight's Consent Agenda. *Councilor Becky Johnson made a motion to approve tonight's Consent Agenda, which was seconded by Councilor Chris Nail and approved by a unanimous voice vote.*

Under **Reading of Petitions, Applications, Complaints, Appeals, Communications, etc.**, there were none.

Under the **City Manager's report**, Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve the General Fund Budget for 2021-2022. *Councilor Becky Johnson made a motion to approve the budget which was seconded by Councilor Bo Johnson and approved by unanimous voice vote.* Mr. Dixon reported the Fund Balances as follows: General Fund \$1,207,167.70, Vehicle Registration \$22,540.21, Contractor Bonds \$155,956.16, Capital Fund \$1,786,825.99, 4 & 5C Gas Fund \$223,678.65, 7 C Gas Fund \$142,747.82, Rebuild Alabama Gas Fund \$100,544.09, Building Fund \$0.00, Paving Supplement Fund \$256,840.98, Reserve Fund \$1,750,000.00, BBT Fund \$42,383.04, BP Sports Income \$52,567.50, BP Sports Expenses (\$81,722.60).

Under **Public Hearings**, there were none.

Under **Resolutions, Ordinances, Orders, and other Business**. Mayor Webster announced there were none.

Under **Mayor and Council Comment**, Mayor Webster.

Councilor LeWayne Allen announced the Covid virus had impacted the Parks participation in the last year but was expected to come back and grow in 2022.

Councilor Becky Johnson reported the Senior Center doing well and continues to grow.
