The City of Clay Receives Right to Use License to Extend Walking Trails

The City of Clay was issued a right to use license today in order to extend the walking trails onto the Department of Youth Services' property in Clay. On a motion made by Senator Linda Coleman, the entire board voted unanimously to approve the land committee's recommendation. The land committee of the Department of Youth Services had voted unanimously earlier in the day to present the recommendation.

The right to use license goes into effect on July 3, 2017. The City of Clay will begin work with The Fresh Water Land Trust and surveyors to design the new trails. Initial construction will at least double the length of the trails currently connected to Cosby Lake.

Mayor Charles Webster and City Manager, Ronnie Dixon, were in Montgomery today to attend the meetings.
