## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2013-20

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama, adopted Ordinance 2013-20, on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2013-20 amends Ordinance 2003-100; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2003-100 levies a city sales and excise tax; and

WHEREAS, the residents of the City of Clay, have been unduly burdened by exorbitant increases grocery cost; and

WHEREAS, the Administration of the City of Clay, have been diligent in managing the finances of the city, and are desirous of relieving some burden from its citizens and patrons; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Ordinance 2013-20 to remove 2% of the levied sales tax of 4% on certain food items as defined by the SNAP program for a period of 2 years, beginning November 1, 2022 and ending October 31, 2024.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama that the 'SALES TAX" of 4% be reduced by 2% on certain food items as defined by the SNAP program for a period of 2 years effective November 1, 2022.
